**AP courses:** 10-point weight is added to individual semester course grades of 70 and above on the transcript. 10-point weight is also added to the final grade for each core content/world language dual enrollment course with a grade of 70 and above.

#### Grading Scale

Class rank is determined by the numeric average for all subjects taken in grades 9-12. Class rank is reported at the end of the fall semester of the senior year. Valedictorian and Salutatorian is confirmed at the end of fall semester of the senior year.

The Midtown High School Signature program is currently transitioning from College and Career Readiness to STEAM. Implementation of this program includes the refinement of the school vision, mission, and culture to provide students educational experience rich in Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts & Mathematics.
